When you leave the bus or train station, turn right. Then turn right and walk down Brook Street to the traffic lights at the bottom.



Go straight across at the traffic lights and walk down to the river bridge.



Just before the bridge crosses the river is a gate. Go down the steps towards the war memorial.



Follow the path along the river.
There is a very good childrens playground on the left.



Carry on and you will reach a fish and chip shop.

There is a public toilet a little further on.



Keep on the path until you reach the bridge.



Go over the bridge.



Turn right and follow the path along the river until you get back to the first bridge. Going for a walk is a good way to get exercise, to meet people, relax and have fun. A gentle walk in the fresh air can help you to feel better physically and mentally.



How to get there
The best way to get to Ilkley is on the train from
Bradford Forster Square. There is no direct bus service
from Bradford to Ilkley.
