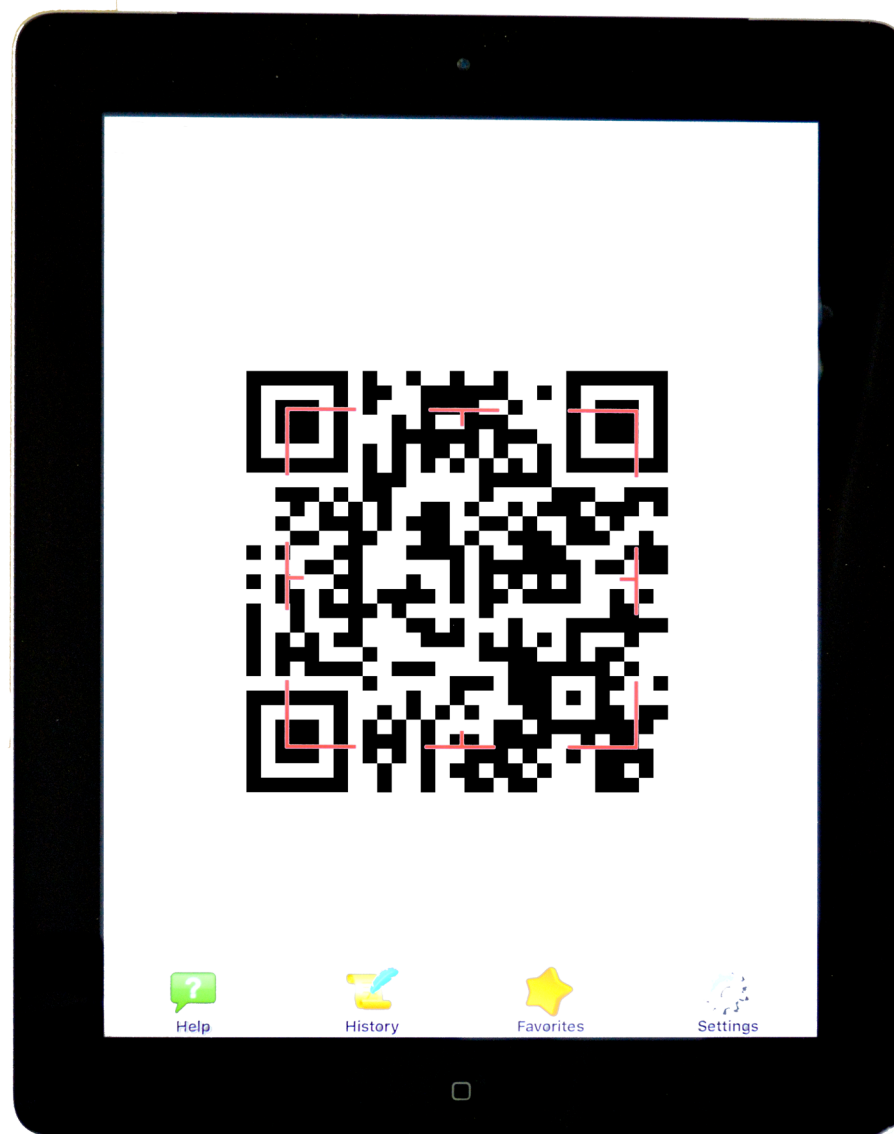
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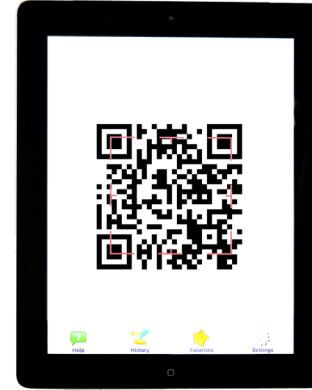

A QR Code is a square code that you can scan with your smart phone or your tablet.



It can give you information in lots of different ways like films, texts and sound.



QR stands for quick response.

QR codes are popular because they are so quick and easy to use.



Your phone must have a camera on it and be able to go on the internet.



To scan a code open the app and point the camera at the QR code you want to scan.



You will need to download an app for a QR scanner.

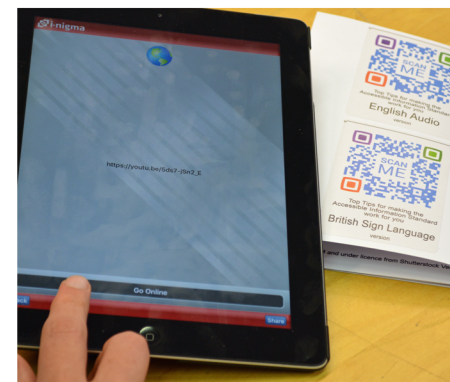
Ask a family member or support worker to help you if you're not sure how to do this.



The camera will scan the QR code automatically.



There are lots of apps that can scan QR codes. We like I-nigma because it works on all phones and tablets.



You then need to press the Go to Page button. This will take you to the information.
