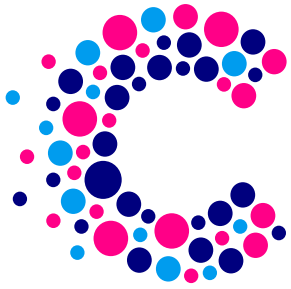
CAN - Empower

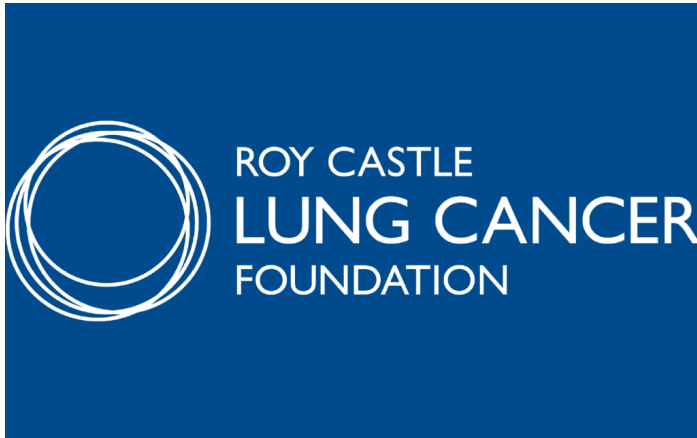
